NOTIFICATION 9 OF 2020

In view of the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic situation the board rules pertaining to the conduct of the Year end examination of the even term of the academic year 2019-20 are modified as follows:

For Diploma in Pharmacy

- i. Board shall conduct Annual Examination for the students of second Year Diploma in Pharmacy.
- ii. Board shall also conduct repeat theory examination for the First And Second year students.
- iii. Special examination shall be conducted for out of State students if they are unable to answer their scheduled examination.
- iv. For all the first year D. Pharm. regular students, marks obtained in the internal test (TM) will be scaled up and considered as marks obtained under head 'Theory (TH)'.
- v. Average of best two of the tests (on-line / off-line) will be considered as TM for all the courses.
- vi. No student shall be detained from moving from first year to second year. However, students who fail, shall have to pass the examination(s) in which he/she has failed, whenever the examination is held next.
- vii. Students who wish to improve the performance shall be permitted to do so, by appearing in the repeat theory exam.
- viii. Practical examinations: Viva-voce and Synopsis/MCQs examinations shall replace practical examinations and which shall be conducted by online mode.
- ix. Revaluation facility shall be extended to only those cases covered under i, ii & iii above.

The above modified rules are applicable only for the Year end examination of academic year 2019-20 for Diploma Programme in Pharmacy.

As far as possible all examinations i.e., oral, test, assignments, etc., (other than term end theory exam) shall be conducted in on-line mode for which purpose suitable mobile apps or email platform may be used.
