<b>2. BLOCK PATTERNS</b>	6
Instructions for drafting, method of drafting, points to remember when drafting, various types of block patterns, parts of a pattern, types of paper patterns, uses of paper pattern and contents of paper patterns, laying of paper patterns.	
<b>3. SPREADING AND CUTTING</b>	6
Facts about fabric grain, off grain, straightening of fabric, shrinkage width of different fabrics, folding fabric. Positioning of marking on paper and cloth cutting and its methods.	
<b>4. FULLNESS IN GARMENTS</b>	6
Darts, pleats gathering and shirring. Pattern for a skirt with waist band and darts and a simple blouse. Application and drafting of different pleats on yokes.	8

#### PRACTICAL

Sample: Stitches of Gathering: Hand and machine.

Pleats: Knife, box pleat, inverted box pleat.

Darts: Fish dart, contour dart released darts, double darts.
