1. COLLARS, YOKES, SLEEVES & CUFFS		32
Yokes: Bodies straight yoke, bodice round neckline yokes, shoulder yoke or midriff yokes.		
Collars: Flat collars- Bertha or puritan collar, peter pan sailor collar, etc. Stand collars- Band collar, shirt collar, shawl collar, notched collar, biased collar, etc. circular flounce collars, cowl neckline, raised neckline. Sleeves and cuffs: Set in sleeves plain, puff, leg-of-mutton, bell, tulip, or petal cap, shirt sleeves, circular sleeve, etc. Sleeve and garment in one: Raglan, dolman or kimono sleeve, magyar sleeve. Cuffs: Shirt cuffs, barrel cuff, turned back cuff, wide fitted cuff, traditional cuff, traditional French cuff, split French cuff, mock French cuff, lapped cuff.		
2. WESTERN DRESS		8
American shirt dress which includes one type of collar, sleeve, yoke, placket and elasticized waist		
3. LADIES JACKET		32
Single or double breasted with two piece bodice, two piece sleeve, shawl and notch collar with lining and vent on center back		

4. SEMI- LINED JACKET

5. LADIES TROUSERS

Different types of trousers, suitable materials used. Tailoring of trousers, by using pleats, pockets fly opening, waistband, trouser hooks and eye. Trousers with and without waistbands.
